## GEOL 457/657: Geothermal Exploration and Development Decisions Based on Resource Conceptual Models

The module is offered to students for 2 academic credits at either the undergraduate or graduate level. A non-credit option is offered to professionals. The module is an intensive course that will run from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM every weekday.

The NGA is intended for outstanding undergraduates, graduate students, and professionals. Strong academic preparation in quantitative fields is expected. This course is open to USA and international applicants.

Professionals do not need to provide this documentation.
